

QFA APPROVED POINT SCORING SYSTEM

(Must be used by Clubs that advertise their Supreme Exhibits will be determined by points)

GUIDELINES

- Judge must have judged all exhibits in Group
- Judge must then rank an Overall Top 10 exhibits in Group on a separate judge's slip that is to be notated NOT TO BE ANNOUNCED
- To be eligible for Supreme an exhibit must have been awarded at least one Best Exhibit in Group

POINTS FOR CALCULATING SUPREME EXHIBIT

Best Exhibit	10
Reserve Exhibit	9
Third	8
Fourth	7
Fifth	6
Sixth	5
Seventh	4
Eighth	3
Ninth	2
Tenth	1
